Angel Fact Sheet

Angels

...myriads and myriads of angelic spirit beings were created during Creation week (Gen 2:1; Exod 20:11; Job 38:7)

...a third of the angels fell with Satan between Gen 2 and 3 (Gen 3:1-7; Rev 12:4)

...the good angels were given the sword, symbolizing the right to capitally punish, making them the first administrators of creature government (Gen 3:24)

...based on later revelation angels could have been instruments of judging man through nature during the pre-Flood world (Gen 4:11-12)

...came into the daughters of men and intermarried with them producing a strange offspring called Nephilim (Gen 6:1-4; Jude 6-7)

...we think this angelic-human intermarriage was an attempt to destroy true humanity and secure angelic rule over the cosmos (destroy the seed promise of Gen 3:15)

...this is a distinct fall of a subset of the good angels, now locked away in a compartment of Hades known as *Tartaros* (2 Pet 2:4; Jude 6-7)

...the offspring called Nephilim were destroyed in the Flood preserving true humanity through Noah, Shem, Ham and Japheth and their wives.

...ate a feast with Lot at Sodom (Gen 19:1-3)

...the good angels were assigned to watch over Israel in the OT (Dan 10:10ff; 12:1)

...the evil angels are assigned by Satan to manipulate, deceive and control the nations (Isa 14:4-15; Ezek 28:12ff ; Dan 10:1-9)

...are able to do miracles that are similar to the miracles only God can do (Exod 7:11-12, 22; 8:7, 18-19; 9:11; 12:12; Matt 24:24; Rev 13:12-15)

...were at Mt Sinai when God delivered the law through angels (Acts 7:38; 53)

...serve as the witnesses of the Mosaic contract made between God and Israel and are called forth to witness court proceedings initiated by God's prosecuting attorneys, the prophets, when Israel violates the contract (Isa 1:2; Mic 1:2)

...can multiply and divide influencing hundreds of people (1 Kgs 22:21-23)

...the evil angels attempted multiple times to destroy the seed promise through human rulers; Pharaoh, Queen Athaliah, Herod, et. al. (Exod 1:8-22; 2 Chron 22:10-12; Matt 2:1-20)

...tried to destroy the sinlessness of Christ through temptations (Matt 4:1-11; Luke 4:1-13)

...can tempt and influence both believers and unbelievers (Gen 3:1-7; Matt 16:22-23). Can possess and control unbelievers who open themselves up to demonic powers (Matt 12:22; 43-45)

...the evil angels thought they had defeated the seed of the woman when Christ was crucified

...the cross of Christ disarmed and defeated the evil angels and Christ made a public display of their defeat (Col 2:15)

...the cross of Christ rendered Satan powerless over death (Heb 2:14-15)

...after the cross the evil angels locked in *Tartaros* had it proclaimed to them by Christ personally that He had personally made it to the cross and their defeat was final (1 Pet 3:18-19)

...the good angels minister to those who inherit salvation (Heb 1:14)

...are court reporters keeping watch on the Churches (Rev 2-3)


...are learning of the manifold wisdom of God through the Church (Eph 3:10)

...the evil angels wage war against us on the spiritual battlefield (Eph 6:11-20)

...there is a war being waged in heaven between the good and evil angels (Rev 12:7-8)

...are assigned to aspects of nature that are used in judging men (Ps 104:4; Rev 7:2)

...surround the throne of God (Rev 4:4; Ezek)



From all this it is implied that...

...angels can temporarily materialize as men and eat, have sex and produce viable offspring that have a hybrid angelic-human DNA structure. These offspring may be the historic basis of the mythological distortions of the Titans and other superhumans

...angels can temporarily morph into wind, fire and smoke acting as conduits of God's revelation
